



Company Overview:

Jeddah's first seawater distillation plant was built in the early 19th century. Kindasa Water Services (KWS) has taken its name from the first plant and was established in January 2000 as the result of a joint venture between below given three leading Saudi business and domestic enterprises.

As one of the Kingdom's prominent companies, the Saudi Industrial Services Company is involved with large scale capital investment in [desalination plants](#), [free zones](#), [Information Technology](#) and [industrial estate development](#), as well as other key projects.

Kindasa produces desalinated [water of consistent quality](#) in compliance with World Health Organization (WHO) and Saudi Arabian Standards Organization (SASO) standards and delivers water to customers on a 24-hour basis.

In addition to quality potable water, KWS is also supplying industrial water in bulk, on a cost-effective basis.

Currently the company operates its main desalination plants inside Jeddah Islamic Port (JIP) with a 2km, 800mm diameter glass reinforced plastic pipeline delivering the potable water to a filling station outside JIP's gate 9, with 16 loading arms.

To meet the [growing demand](#) for potable water in the Jeddah area, KWS recently commissioned a new plant of 25,500cu.m per day capacity , which has three trains each capable to 8,500cu.m per day.

In January 2009, [KWS established Kindasa-Yemen](#) and will be constructing 1,000 to 10,000 cu. M per day SWRO desalination plant on Build-Operate-Own (BOO) basis to supply water to citizens, industries, etc.

The direction of this growing enterprise is in the hands of a team of well-trained professionals led by Chief Executive Officer, Fawzi Habhab, who has more than [25 years experience](#) in strategic planning and project management.

Kindasa [corporate philosophy](#) is to nurture new talent, and the company has installed special plant simulation systems to train young Saudis, thereby boosting the economy and the development of the nation as a whole.
